

REINSTATEMENT OF RESIDENCY

(to be signed one (1) year prior to election)

ELECTION ORDINANCE

Constitution Article VIII Section 5 (a) 2 – Election Ordinance Article VI Section 6.01(a) 2
Is a resident of the Reservation for at least one (1) year, or, has resided in the Round Valley area for at least one (1) year consecutively prior to the election date uninterruptedly

- a. It shall be the responsibility of the Tribal Member who have just recently moved back to and currently reside in the Round Valley Area as a permanent resident to reinstate their eligibility to participate in Community Elections with the Election Board.*
- b. Tribal members who have recently moved back to and currently reside in the Round Valley Area, but have not made any attempt to reinstate themselves and cannot show written documentation as to when they moved back and stated their residence on or near the reservation, will not be considered eligible even though they may have been present on or near the reservation for the required one-year period.*
